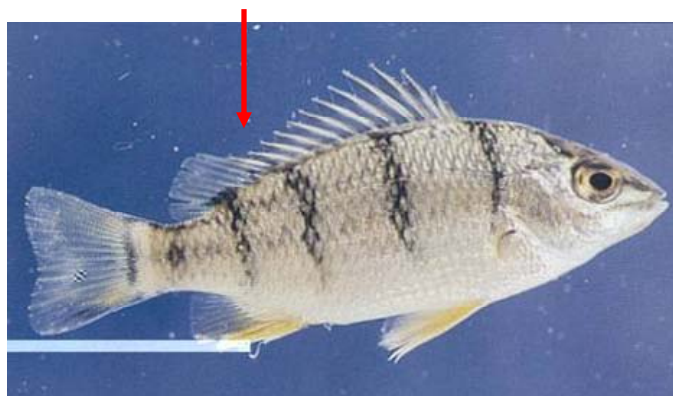
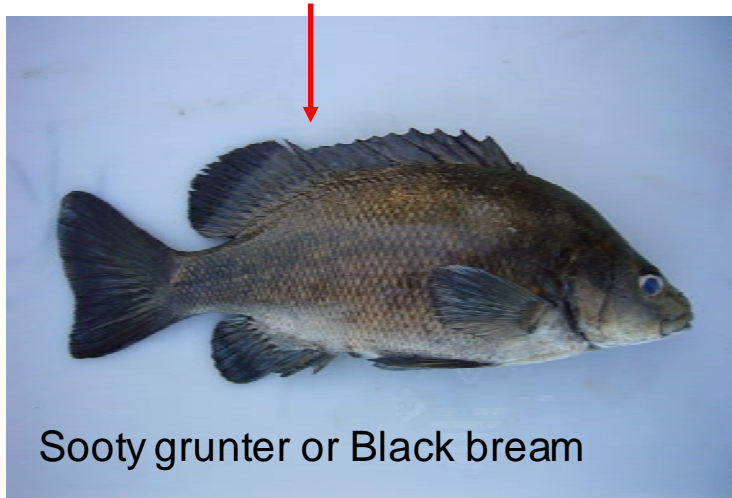


HOW TO IDENTIFY TILAPIA

Native fish have a gap or dent between front and rear parts of their top fin –
Tilapia have a continuous top fin with no gap or dent



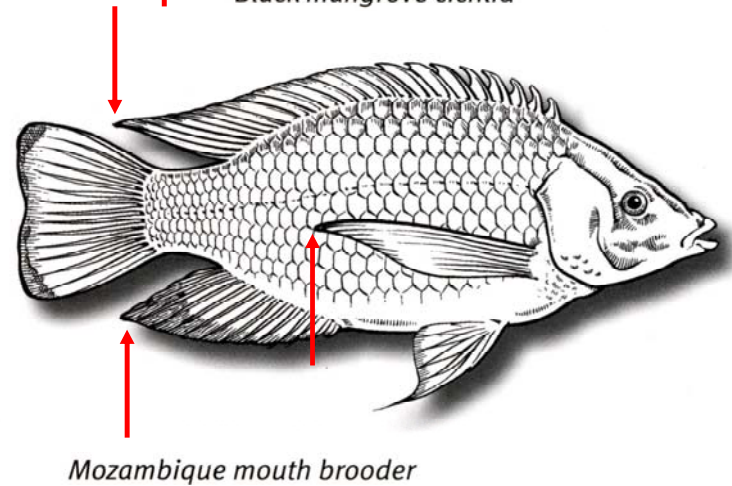
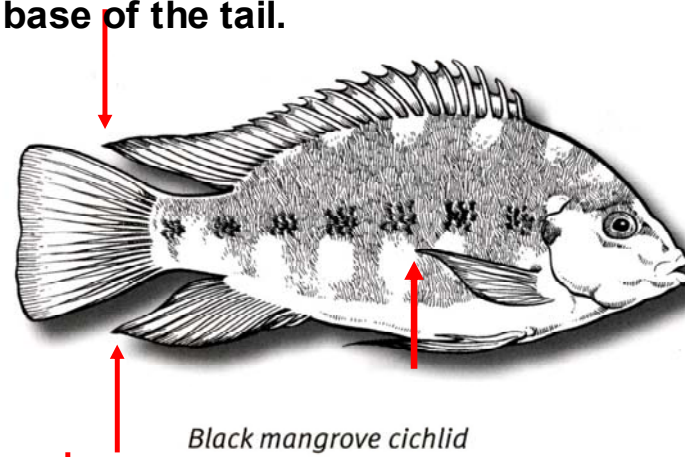
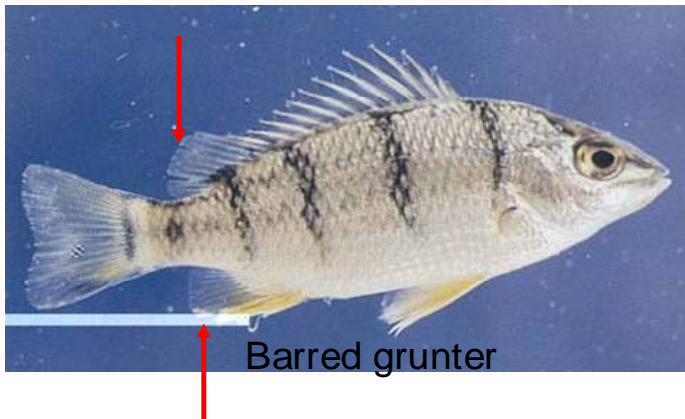
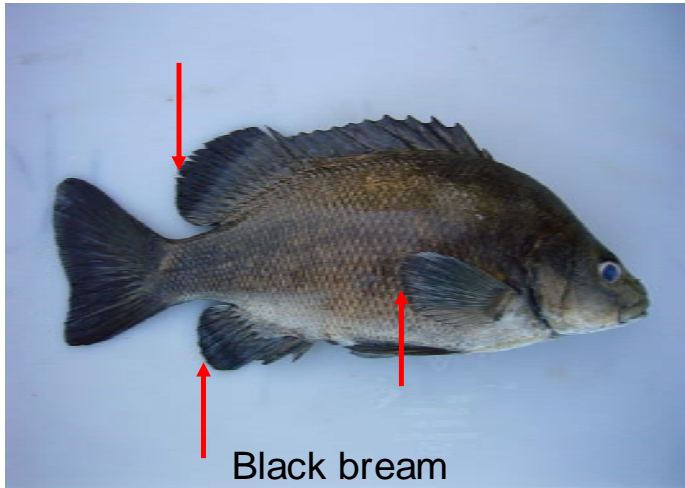

HOW TO IDENTIFY TILAPIA

Native fish have rounded fins, Tilapia have pointed fins with the top fin extending over the base of the tail.



HOW TO IDENTIFY TILAPIA

Display Pits – Mozambique tilapia only



The male Mozambique Tilapia creates these circular display pits on the river bed to attract the female and each fish defends his pit vigorously, also excluding native fish from the Tilapia infested area.
